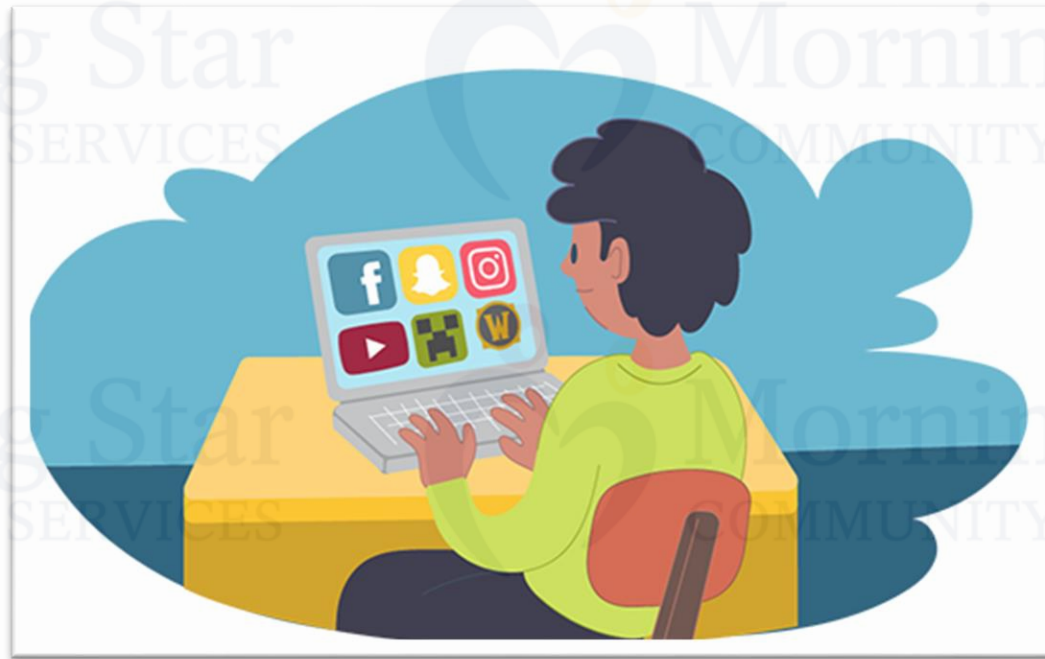

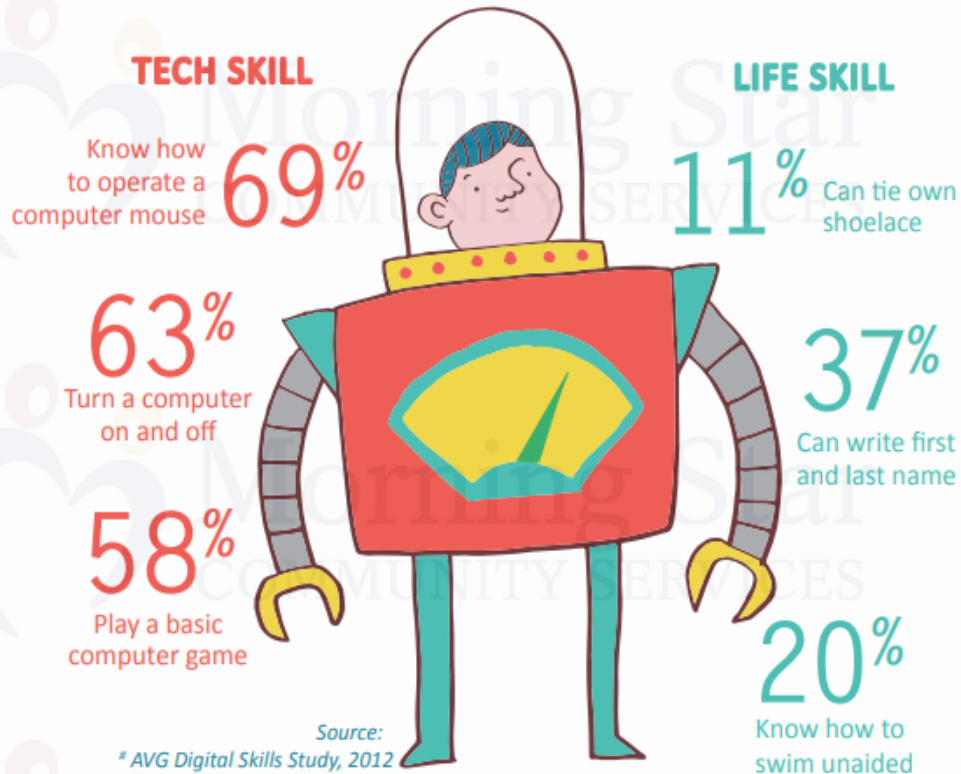

# Preventive Teaching

## What is Preventive Teaching?

Teaching and talking to children about expected behaviours regarding IT-related usage.

## When to do it?

Before the problem behaviour is shown.

To prevent old problem behaviours from happening again.

Talk to the child when s/he is in receptive mood.

# Preventive Teaching

## Family Media Use Plan

1. Screen Free zones
2. Screen Free Times
3. Device Curfew
4. Choose and diversify media
5. Balancing Online & Offline time
6. Manners matter
7. Digital citizenship & safety
8. Sleep & Exercise



# Engaging children Offline



## In public spaces

1. I-spy
2. Spot the differences
3. Shoot
4. Activity book, puzzles, jokes, riddles

# Role Play

- Talk to your child about your expectations on Internet usage.



## Steps to Preventive Teaching

1. Describe what behaviours you want to see.
2. Give child a reason for behaviours.
3. Share consequences for acceptable and unacceptable behaviours.
4. Practise with child to clarify understanding.

# Preventive Teaching

## Setting Limits & Boundaries (Sample)

### Consequences

Positive  
(Rewards)

Extra outdoor activities – tennis, hiking, cycling  
Extra indoor activities – drawing, painting, baking  
***Expose child to alternatives to Internet activities.***

Negative  
(Removal of  
privileges)

Less Internet time.  
Less outdoor play time.  
Less TV time.



# Corrective Teaching

# Corrective Teaching

... is attending to child's problem behaviours as it happens with teaching and practising alternative ways of behaviours.

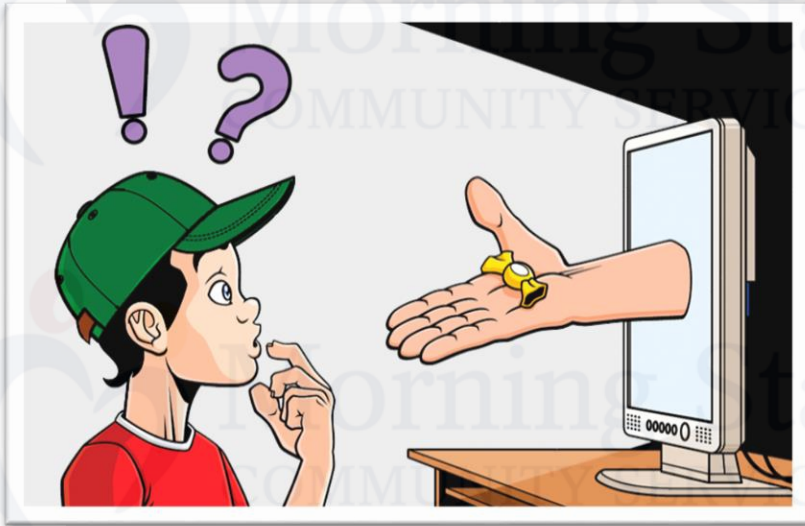
## Steps to Corrective Teaching

1. Stop the problem behaviour.
2. Describe what you want.
3. Practise what you want.
4. Give a consequence.



# Teaching Self-Care

# Teaching Self-Care



- \* How much time can a child be online?
- \* Is personal information kept private?
- Internet scams?
- \* To click or not to click on Pop ups?
- \* In-app purchases?

# Supporting Self-Care

1. Install the necessary security tools like anti-virus and firewall
2. Use parental control tools to block Unsuitable content
3. Teach your child to recognize and avoid internet scams
4. Introduce rules and routines

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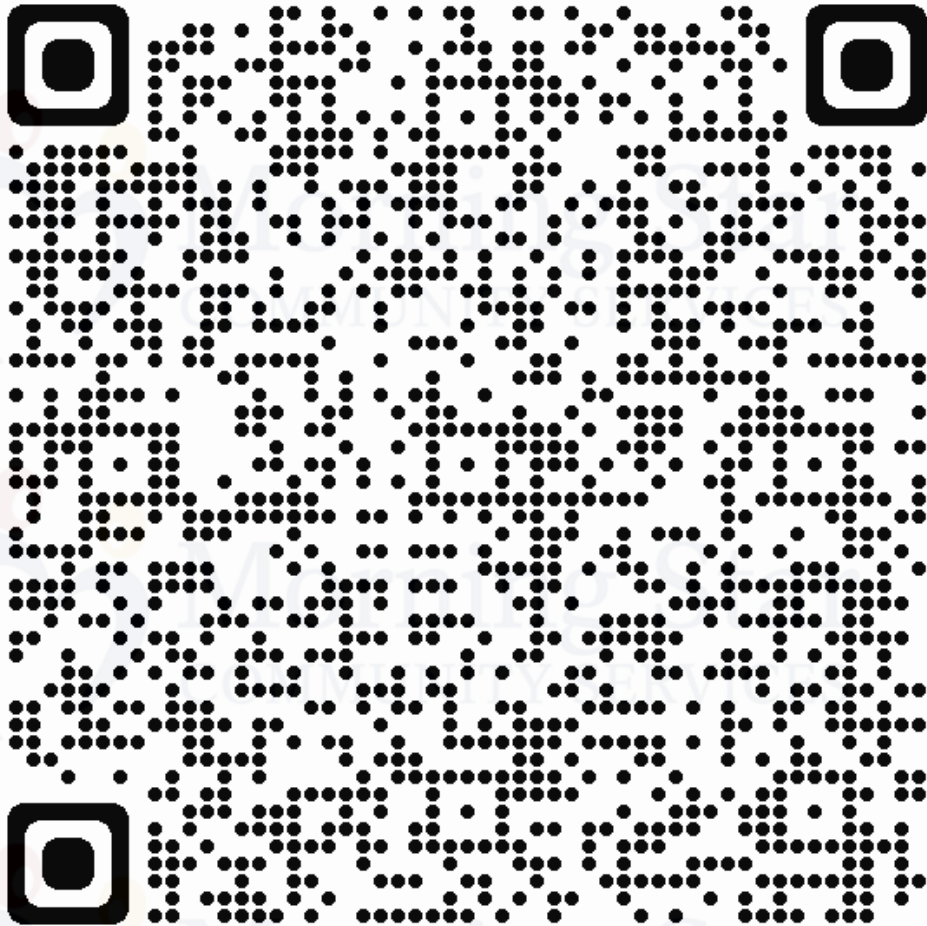
