

2020 P1 REGISTRATION EXERCISE (FOR ADMISSION TO P1 IN 2021)

Children born between 2 January 2014 and 1 January 2015 (both dates inclusive) can participate in the 2020 P1 Registration Exercise for admission to P1 classes in 2021. Parents of Singapore Citizen (SC) / Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR) children may proceed to the school of choice during their eligible phase to register their child for the P1 Registration Exercise.

In line with the measures announced by the Government to further enhance safe distancing measures and ensure minimal contact among the public, there will be **no in-person registration** at schools for the 2020 P1 registration. You may register your child online in a phase as long as you fulfil **at least one** of the requirements for that phase.

2B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are a parent volunteer at the school, starting before 1 July 2019 and completing at least 40 hours of service by 30 June 2020. You are a member endorsed by the church or clan directly connected to the school. You are endorsed as an active community leader. 	From 23 July 2020 (Thu), 9am to 24 July 2020 (Fri), 4.30pm. <u>Announcement of Result via sms:</u> 30 July 2020 (Thu)
2C	If your child is eligible for P1 and not yet registered in a primary school.	Registration via P1-IS From 3 August 2020 (Mon), 9am to 5 August 2020 (Wed), 4.30pm

Singapore Citizen (SC)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Child's birth certificate. Child's Singapore Citizenship Certificate, if not a Singapore Citizen at the time of birth. Child's <u>immunisation records</u>. Singapore NRIC of both parents.
Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Child's birth certificate. Child's entry or re-entry permit if they are Singapore Permanent Residents (PR). Child's <u>immunisation records</u>. Entry permit or re-entry permits of both parents if you are PRs.

2A1	<u>To show you are an alumni member:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A scanned copy of the school report book that clearly shows your spouse's or your name and the primary school, or the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) certificate. • Letter from the alumni association certifying the status and date joined as an alumni member (the join date should not be later than 30 June 2019). <p><u>To show you are a member of the School Advisory or Management Committee:</u> Relevant document to certify parents are members of School Advisory/Management Committee.</p>
2A2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A scanned copy of the school report book that clearly shows the name of you, your spouse or your older child and the primary school, or the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) certificate. • Birth certificate of older child as proof of relationship (if applicable).
2B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A letter of eligibility by the <u>People's Association</u> for being an endorsed active community leader. <p>If you are an endorsed active community leader, you will need to clarify with your constituency office on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Whether your child is eligible for this registration phase. • How to apply for the eligibility letter. • The list of schools you will be allowed to apply for. <p>If you or your spouse are current parent volunteers at the school, the school will verify your child's eligibility with their records during registration. To qualify for this phase, you must have started before 1 July 2019 and completed 40 hours of service by 30 June 2020.</p>

With effect from the 2020 P1 Registration Exercise, there will be a cap on the intake of Permanent Resident (PR) children during the P1 registration Exercise. This is to provide a more balanced intake of Singapore Citizen and Singapore Permanent Resident children, so as to have a more conducive environment to encourage interaction of PR children in the primary schools, and to facilitate integration of PR children into Singapore. Opera Estate Primary School is one of the 10 schools that will be implementing the cap during the Phases 2C and 2C supplementary.

Singapore Citizens (SCs) will be given absolute priority over Singapore Permanent Residents (PRs) when balloting is necessary in a specific phase.
